Hastings Co-op will expand its family of Department Stores with the opening of a pop up shop in Laurieton next month.

“For many years, we’ve been asked when we would have a presence in the Camden Haven, so this is a great opportunity to expand the Department Store to three stores - in Port Macquarie, Wauchope and Laurieton,” Hastings Co-op’s chief executive officer Allan Gordon said.

The Department Store is an important part of the Hastings Co-op family, which includes 15 businesses across the Hastings.

The community-owned co-operative employs more than 300 people across seven business units including fuel, supermarkets, liquor stores, department stores, hardware and farm supplies, cafes and Bago Bluff condiment manufacturing.
